DISTINCT LICENSES ARE ISSUED FOR BLS, ALS, OR SPECIALIZED AMBULANCE VEHICLES AND A SPECIFIC VEHICLE MAY NOT BE USED TO PROVIDE A HIGHER LEVEL OF SERVICE THAN THAT WHICH IT HAS BEEN LICENSED TO PROVIDE, UNLESS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY MIEMSS. POST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH COMAR 30.09. SHOULD YOU GO OUT OF BUSINESS OR PERMANENTLY PLACE ANY LICENSED AMBULANCE VEHICLE OUT OF SERVICE OR SELL ANY SUCH VEHICLE, RETURN ALL RELEVANT LICENSES TO THE STATE OFFICE OF COMMERCIAL AMBULANCE LICENSING & REGULATION, MIEMSS, 653 WEST PRATT STREET, BALTIMORE, MARYLAND 21201 (410) 706-8511.
