DISTINCT LICENSES ARE ISSUED FOR BLS, ALS, OR SPECIALIZED AMBULANCE VEHICLES AND A SPECIFIC VEHICLE MAY NOT BE USED TO PROVIDE A HIGHER LEVEL OF SERVICE THAN THAT WHICH IT HAS BEEN LICENSED TO PROVIDE, UNLESS EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY MIEMSS. FOST IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH COMAR 30,09.
